Caring for Orphans in India

Pastor Raj has taken in 22 orphan children who are in need of a permanent shelter. We refer to them as the "Compassion Kids". Pastor Raj sold some of his agricultural land to begin the project and with the help of the generous contributors to WCO, the building is making substantial progress and should be completed soon.

Albino Children in Tanzania

Last month we brought the need of the Tabora care home for albino and unwanted children to you. We failed to mention that albino people are in constant danger from witch doctors who think their flesh is filled with magic powers. Albinos have been murdered and butchered for their flesh. Thus, there is an exceptional need to have a safe place for these children.

We were able to send \$3000 to Bishop Mulenga this past month. This is short of what is needed. We hope to raise additional support to help complete the needed maintenance at the home. The following is Bishop Mulenga's request, repeated from last month.

From Bishop Mulenga: "This is Tabora Tanzania at our FPCT center where we take care of children and teach people with skin problems, albinos, some of them have strange eyes, some of them have different looks, their parents don't like them and they seem to be isolated. The church has taken this responsibility in the beginning of the construction of classrooms and the Swedish people helped us with the construction and the availability of equipment. And the government pays us for 4 teachers and the Church pays for 5 teachers, a total of 9 teachers. The Swedes withdrew aid. At the moment we have needs for the repair of toilets and beds and medicines to treat them. The cost is 35m tsh (\$15,000 US). There are many things in terms of needs, but this is very important for them, a large percentage of them come from very low-income families."



Our emphasis at WCO is reaching the lost with the gospel message. That said, we are also called to demonstrate our love with action. This is an opportunity to assist a partner church in their ministry to help these most disadvantaged children.
